

# Penalty Notice Fines For school attendance are changing!

The Department for Education have made the following changes to pupils' absence from the 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2024

### First Term Time Holiday or irregular unauthorised attendance

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular unauthorised Attendance the amount will be:

- £160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days
- Reduced to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days

## Second term time holiday or irregular unauthorised attendance (within 3 years)

The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular unauthorised Attendance the amount will be:

 $\bullet$  £160 per parent, per child to be paid within 28 day. There will be no reduced rate.

### Third term time holiday or irregular unauthorised attendance (with 3 years)

On the third occasion of a Term Time Leave or Irregular unauthorised Attendance, a Penalty Notice will not be issued, and the case will be presented straight to the Magistrates' Court and fines can be issued of up to £2500 per parent, per child. Cases found guilty in Magistrates' Court can show on a parent's DBS Certificate, due to failure to safeguard a child's education.

### Just 10 Sessions 5 days absence

Just 10 sessions (5 Days) Penalty Notice Fines can be issued by the Local Authority when there have been 10 unauthorised absences within a 10-week period (this is just 5 school days). Please work with us by ensuring regular communication, providing medical evidence for absences and avoiding term-time holidays.
