



## Using a Reward Chart

**A reward chart is aimed at encouraging a child to comply or to behave in a certain way.**

**A chart can last for a week, a day or just for a shorter time than that.**

**There will be a number of stars or tokens for a child to collect.**

**The chart will specify what a child needs to do in a positive way, for example, “Kind hands” as opposed to “no hitting.”**

**If a child complies with the behaviour on the chart he/she will get a star.**

**A full chart may mean a tangible reward/treat to motivate them to continue to comply. Sometimes just getting the star is enough. (you know the child best)**

**Children may use reward charts at home but bring them in to show their teacher. Their teacher could then make a fuss of them/give them a reward in school.**
