## Traffic Light Visuals

Plain coloured laminated circles are a clear way of showing a child what you want them to do. Show the circle to the child, point to it and say the appropriate word. You may wish to change the intonation of a voice or sign too to add a clue.


> Red = "Stop"

> Orange = "wait"

Yellow = "nearly" or "nearly done" This is a good way of telling a child that something will soon stop
Green = "go" or OK.

Consistency is important. A child may laugh or take no notice at first but you need to persist with the use of the visuals and show that you mean what you are saying. To make the message clearer everyone needs to do the same.
